- Comply with the rules, constitution, and by-laws of the Association.
- Not willfully act in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the Association
- Keep fully up to date with the Laws of the Game and AWFA regulations as they relate to local variations to the Laws by attending organised seminars, training sessions and monthly general meetings of the Association.
- Uphold the spirit of the game at all times and
 - Extend courtesy to all players, club officials and AWFA Officials
 - Extend courtesy and respect to all fellow referees irrespective as to whether as a player, official or spectator
 - Accept constructive comment regarding any short comings from a member of the Examination Bd. or Education & Development Bd. in a proper manner
 - Refrain from criticisms or adverse comment about a fellow member or the Association "behind their back"
- Refer all problems involving the Association or fellow members to the Association Executive
- Inspect the ground, appurtenances, and player's equipment prior to games.
- Properly instruct assistant referees prior to the game
- Wear only the approved uniform and ensure the official assistant referees' uniform is consistent with the referee's uniform to create a "team" appearance.
- Ensure all paperwork including team sheets, dockets, caution, and send-off reports are properly completed and forwarded so to ensure they are forwarded within 72 hours of completion of the game.
- Advise Appointments Bd. by 5:00 pm Friday if unable to complete a weekend appointment
- Conduct themselves in a professional and well-behaved manner.
